

As part of our commitment to offer quality care and a life reimagined, Rockpool is honoured to offer residents an opportunity to be part of the Wishing Tree Project, which allows them to "request or wish" for something they have never done or would like to do again.

So far, more than 30 resident wishes have been granted. If a resident has a physical disability and can't go 'hot air ballooning' or 'swimming with the dolphins', we can arrange a "virtual" wish experience.

The Wishing Tree Project has been a huge success, with residents reporting they feel respected, acknowledged and well regarded after their experience.

Importantly, Rockpool team members are often part of the experience.

Residents can submit their wish by completing a yellow form, which are available outside the Nurse Stations at both Carseldine and Morayfield. Alternatively, residents can contact reception.

Rockpool non-executive director, Cathy Meyer oversees the Wishing Tree Project and ensures residents' wishes come true.

Love lifts us up where we belong...


Love is all around...


