I am excited to share some important updates and improvement we are



implementing to enhance your experience with us. At Rockpool, our commitment to delivering our promise of a "Life Reimagined" is at the heart of everything we do. Our dedicated team continually learns from your feedback and strives to push the boundaries of service and care excellence.

We have recently strengthened our clinical teams by introducing an additional Care Coordinator and a Nurse Supervisor. The new Care Coordinator will enhance communication with residents and families, support our Clinical Manager, and provide our team with essential training and additional support. The Nurse Supervisors will offer shift leadership seven days a week, ensuring our team is better supported to deliver superior care and service. Each home will communicate these new appointments.

I want to reassure you that we take our responsibility to maintain the right team coverage very seriously. Our staffing requirements are measured by care minutes, which are based on our resident population and reported to the government every quarter. I am pleased to share that Rockpool homes consistently meet or exceed our care minute requirements.

We are also pleased to inform you that Rockpool's medication management system will transition to the Telstra Health Medication Management system. This change integrates all of Rockpool's clinical management systems, offering a safer and more efficient way to manage medications for our residents. Our partnership with Aspect Pharmacy remains unchanged, and we encourage you to consider switching to Aspect if you are using an alternative pharmacy. This allows your GP to prescribe electronically, ensuring prompt medication delivery to the facility. For any questions, please reach out to your Clinical Manager.

You might notice a different tone when you call us; this is part of our updates to our call flows to be more responsive to your calls.

Our Pelican Waters home continues to grow, now with over 100 residents. I am proud to announce the permanent appointment of Rebecca (Bec) Burgess as Facility Manager. I also hear the buggy is a hit with residents, especially with the new shops opened at the Marina.

I hope to see you soon at one of our Rocks Cafes, which are becoming thriving hubs with brilliant coffee and food. Don't forget to pick up a loyalty card—residents receive one free coffee per month from the café.
